The first round of the Pennants was played on the 28th. Grade 4 played Crookwell 1 with Elaine's team going down 15 to 21 and Ann's team lost 41 to 4. In their second match, playing Goulburn, Ann's team had a 28 all draw, while Elaine's team went down 11 to 27.

Round three saw the teams getting a little closer with Elaine's team going down 18/23 and Ann's team losing 15/28 against Crookwell 2.

In Grade 3, playing Goulburn at Bowral, Enid's team won 28 to 18 and Gail's team won 23 to 17.

In their return match, Goulburn won both rinks 21 to 17 but had a lower margin so Bowral won the Grade 3 Pennants by 8 shots over all.
