Conditions of Play 2020

- The event will be played over three weeks: Saturday 5th September; 12 September; and Saturday 19
 September 2020.
- Week 1: (Saturday 05/09/2020 1:00 PM Two bowl fours of 21 ends
- Week 2: (Saturday 12/09/2020) 1: OO PM- Player 1; singles of 31 ends. Players 2, 3 and 4, three bowl triples of 21 ends
- Week 3: (Saturday 19/09/2020) 1:00 PM- Player 2 and 4, players 1 and 3, Pairs of 21 ends.
- 1. In the event of inclement weather, provided all teams reach 12 ends (18 for singles); the results will be declared at 12 ends of each game.
- 2. One trial end will be allowed before each game.
- 3. A draw is a valid result. No extra end will be played.
- 4. Scoring; aggregate shots of each game; winners determined by the highest total shots scored.
- 5. Dead ends apply to be replayed
- 6. Prize money; First \$700, Second \$320, Third \$80.
- 7. Green Fees for each game is \$20 which includes after game snacks.
- 8. The aggregate of the handicaps of all four bowlers in a team must be at least 25.
- 9. There will be a "blind draw" which will include teams and rinks.
- 10. An even number of teams is required to run this event. The Bowls Secretary may either delete the last team entered or constitute an extra team after the closing time of the event.
- 11. The controlling body reserves the right to alter the format and will have final control to ensure smooth running of the competition.
