

## Pennant Update Week 10

The 2018 pennant season is now complete except for those teams which have been successful in reaching the Zone Finals.

At Bowral the Grade 3 topped the ladder in Section 1. The Bowral grade 6 team finished second and the grade 7 team third.

Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> May was the Final round for the Grade 6 and 7 teams.

Grade 6 played the Camden Men's No3 side and had a very good win of 10-0 points. All three sides won with the final score 78-28 shots.
